## CONSERVATION



Protected an additional 483 acres for a total of 30,980 acres. Submitted five grant proposals for \$6.25 million for the final phase of El Dorado Ranch and conservation easement projects.

## STEWARDSHIP



Completed the American River Headwaters project with a total of 1,972 acres thinned between 2015-2024, among many other forest health improvements. Engaged volunteers in land stewardship, water quality monitoring, trail building, river cleanups and other stewardship programs.

## EDUCATION



Delivered programs to 14 new classes and 15 returning classes and secured \$15,000 to launch teacher training to support environmental education in local classrooms.

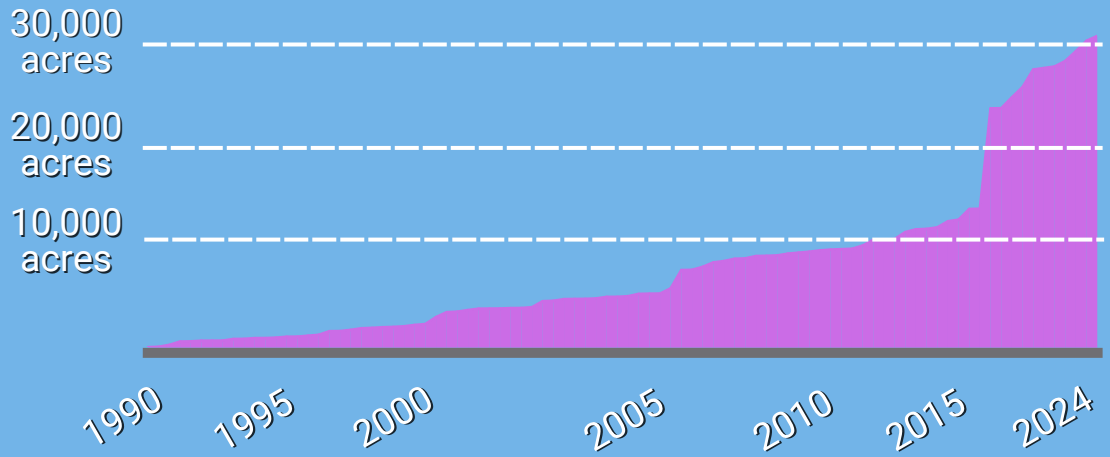

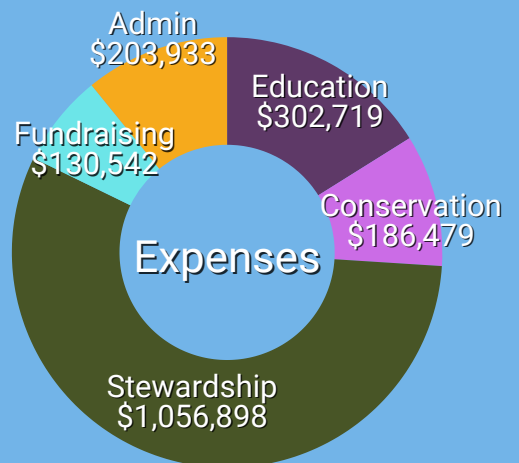
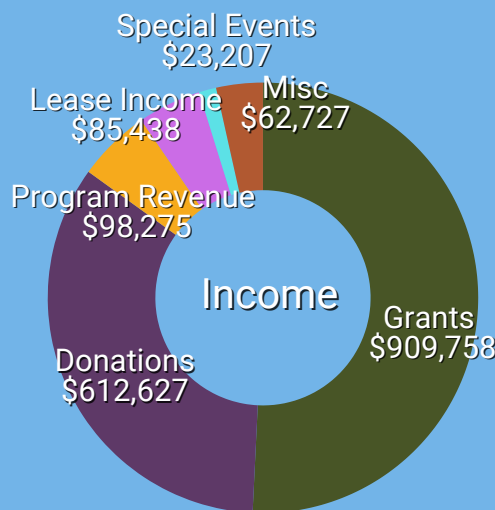


## STRONGER EVERY YEAR
