Protected an additional 40 acres to secure public access at El Dorado Ranch – for a total of 31,120 acres protected to date. Returned 320 acres of ancestral land to Cosumnes Culture & WaterWays, the first landback in El Dorado County.

STEWARDSHIP



Engaged hundreds of community members with meaningful opportunities to steward, monitor, and connect with protected land through various habitat restoration projects and stewardship programs.

EDUCATION



Delivered programs to 26 schools and launched teacher training programs to support environmental education in local classrooms. Led 146 campers and counselors through Nature Camp.

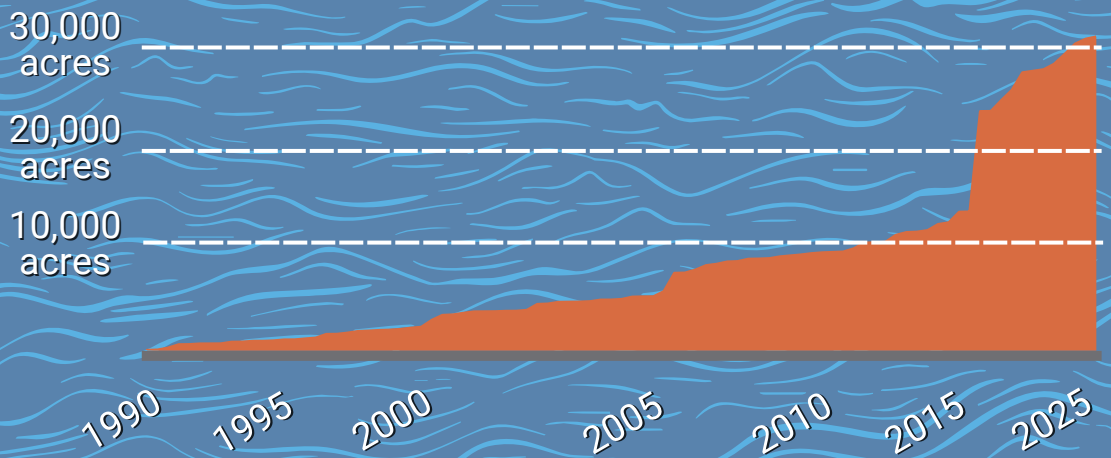

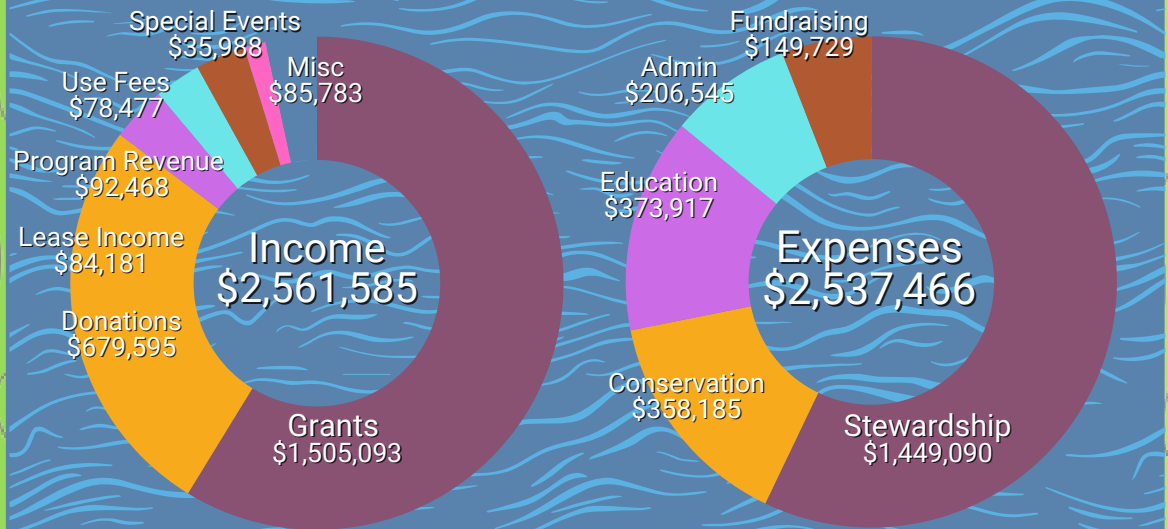
